

**An Analysis of the Career Interests and Work Habits of the Grade 11 Students of
La Consolacion University Philippines**

Abstract

The study analyzed the career interest and work habits of 574 Grade 11 students at La Consolacion University Philippines. The study was descriptive and utilized a standardized tool that measured six career interests areas based on the Theory of John Holland and work habits indicated by planning and organizing, initiative and being team players. Results revealed that majority are moderately interested in conventional, artistic and enterprising career areas and had very low preferences for realistic, social and investigative career interest areas. In addition, findings also showed that majority of the students have moderate habits of planning and organizing and having initiative in work and performing cooperatively as an effective member of the team.
